

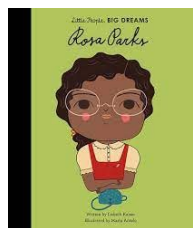
TERMS 1 & 2 - 2025-2026 - Movers and Shakers

Welcome to Year 2!

Our year kicks off with the topic 'Movers and Shakers'. In this project, children will study a range of significant people, including explorers (Christopher Columbus and Neil Armstrong) and activists (Emmeline Pankhurst and Rosa Parks) and think carefully about the impact of their actions. The children will also carry out an independent study of a significant person from the past and learn about some people who are significant today.



English

In English, we will learn a biography of Mahatma Gandhi, an adventure narrative based on local explorer, Julius Brenchley, and a persuasive poster about votes for women. Our main book study will be 'Little People, Big Dreams; Rosa Parks' by Lisbeth Kaiser. We will also look at some other *Little People, Big Dreams* books. Our class library day is Monday.

Maths

In Maths we will be exploring numbers to 100 including counting in threes, addition and subtraction including adding and subtracting two digit numbers, and 2D and 3D shapes.

Science

In Science we will be exploring habitats and how they are suited to support the lives of the various creatures that inhabit them. We will also look at human survival, learning about the basic needs of humans, including the importance of exercise, nutrition and good hygiene. We will learn how human offspring grow and change over time into adulthood.



Experience Day and Educational Visit

Our experience day for this topic will be focused on children dressing up as their favourite historically significant individual. On this day we will have topic-centred activities whereby children will have fun and gain an in-depth understanding of the lives of significant individuals. Our educational visit will be to Maidstone Museum, to learn more about Julius Brenchley.
