



Activity:

<p>Make a face using fruit and post a picture onto Tapestry. Alternatively, draw a face made of fruit in your homework book.</p> <p>Challenge: Can you change the expression on your fruit face?</p> 	<p>Rhyming words sound the same e.g. cat and mat. We have been practising finding rhyming words at school. Can you think of some rhyming words?</p> <p>Write and draw 3 pairs of rhyming words into your homework book. e.g. cat and mat, dig and pig, sun and run.</p> 	<p>Practise breaking numbers into two parts. How many different ways can you make six? e.g.: 3 and 3 make 6. What other ways can you think of?</p> <p>Use objects to help you count.</p> <p>Challenge: Can you try some other amounts?</p> 	<p>Can you practise putting on your coat and zipping it up, all on your own?</p> <p>Challenge: Can you put your jumper on the right way by yourself and take it off by yourself. You could post photos on tapestry.</p> 	<p>Look through a favourite book from home. Can you find any of the new 'red words' we have learnt? Write them down in your books.</p> <p>Challenge: Write a sentence using some red words.</p> <p style="color: red;">Red words include: I, the, to, my, of, no, said, you, was, your, and</p>	<p>Draw a picture of a plant or tree.</p> <p>Explore looking at plants and trees around you.</p> <p>Challenge: Can you label the parts of the plant on your picture?</p> 	<p>Complete the independence activities in your Duke Awards book and stick some photographs in.
