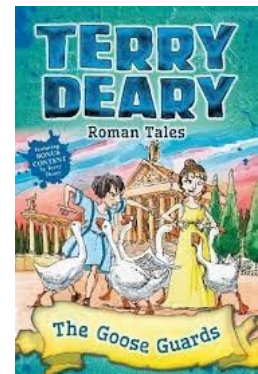
Topic for the Term—Empires and Emperors
