School Uniform

- ✓ Ensure that my child wears school uniform, including appropriate shoes, and has a PE kit in school at all times.
- ✓ Ensure that all uniform and personal belongings are clearly marked with the child's name.
- ✓ Ensure that my child does not wear jewellery, except a watch.

Care & Discipline

- ✓ Support the School's Policies and Guidelines for achieving good behaviour including anti-bullying and anti-racism strategies.
- ✓ Ensure that my child uses the internet, social networking and e-mail facilities responsibly adhering to the Acceptable Use Policy.

Working together

- ✓ Work with the school to ensure that my child achieves his/her potential academically and socially.
- ✓ Support the school's policy for valuing all members of the school community by encouraging my child to be tolerant and respectful.

- ✓ Issue fixed penalty notices for any term time holidays.
